The State Bar recently received your written charge against Kenneth J. Love. After reviewing your allegations and discussing them with Mr. Love and the prosecutor's office we have determined that further investigation is not warranted and our file has been closed.

This decision was based on the following: It is my understanding the case against Mr. Love has been or will be resolved without a conviction. Based on the fact that Mr. Love was charged with a misdemeanor the State Bar would be unable to prove a violation of the ethical rules by clear and convincing evidence.

Pursuant to Rule 70(a)(4), Ariz. R. Sup. Ct., the record of this charge will be public for six months from the date of this letter. Pursuant to Rule 71, Ariz. R. Sup. Ct., the State Bar file may be expunged in three years.
